


Thailand aerosol production jumps almost 4%...

The TAA released figures for 2017 aerosol production in Thailand at its General Meeting in April. Total aerosol production last year was 299.6 million cans, up from 289 million in 2016. Tinplate steel accounted for almost 140 million cans, while aluminum cans numbered 160 million. Compared with 2016, aerosol fillings in Thailand grew almost 3.67%.

Personal care products were the most popular at 40%. Insect Sprays accounted for 23%, followed by Spray Paint at 20%, Household at 12%, Industrial at 4% and Others at 1%.

The TAA now has 25 member companies with the addition of RB in 2018 and Chaturong and PTT in 2017. SPRAY
