



The **Thai** aerosol industry sees ups and downs in a pandemic year...

The Thai Aerosol Association (TAA) reported that total aerosol production in 2020 was 286.628 million cans. This is a decrease of 4.7% from 2019.

There were 183.128 million tinplate steel cans filled in 2020, as well as 103.5 million aluminum aerosol cans filled. Aluminum can fillings decreased 18.5% while steel can fillings increased 5.3%.

Seven categories were represented with the debut of the *Pharmaceutical, Veterinary & Animal Care* category; the TAA indicated that the *Food* category represented 0% of fillings and was therefore not included in its 2020 statistics.

According to TAA Secretary Pornsak Tangprapa, the *Personal Care* category was impacted negatively by the COVID-19 pandemic due to social distancing measures such as working from home and the closure of bars and restaurants.

The *Household* category did well due to increased demand for disinfectant products, TAA reported. **SPRAY**
