



European aerosol

European aerosol production figures were recently released by the European Aerosol Federation (FEA).

Aerosol units produced in Europe totaled 5.2 billion in 2020, down from 5.492 billion in 2019—a decrease of 5.6%. Personal care products accounted for 54.4% of production, while Household Care accounted for 23.5%.

The UK led production with 28.5%, followed by Germany (19.7%). France (12.3%), Italy (9.4%), The Netherlands (7.5%), Spain (5.4%) and Others (17.2%).

European production

According to reported fillings for European aerosol products, overall unit production reached **5.2 billion in 2020**, reflecting again a slight decrease from previous production numbers.

Production per country

United Kingdom, Germany and France provide more than 60% of the annual aerosol production in Europe in all segments. Together with Italy, Netherlands and Spain, more than 4.0 billion units of aerosol dispensers are produced in 2020.





Fig.2. Aerosol production by country (2020)

Production by segment

Aerosol containers are primarily made of steel and aluminium whereas glass and plastic containers remain marginal. Cosmetics and household products represent more than three quarter of the European production.
