European aerosol production in 2022



Overall unit production grew to more than 5.3 billion...

uropean aerosol production figures were recently released by the European Aerosol Federation (Fédération Européenne des Aérosols or FEA).

Aerosol units produced in Europe totaled 5.319 billion in 2022, up from 5.242 billion in 2021—an increase of 1.47%. Of the more than 16 billion units produced globally, 5.3 billion are filled in Europe, according to the FEA.

Aerosol containers in Europe are primarily made of steel and aluminum, whereas glass and plastic containers remain marginal.

Personal Care and Household Care products represent more than three quarters of European aerosol production. Indeed, Personal Care products accounted for 55.1% of production, while Household Care accounted for 21.1%. The Others category—Automotive/Industrial; Paint/Varnish; Food/Miscellaneous; Pharma/Vet—accounted for 23.8%.

The UK led production with 27%, followed by Germany (18.3%), France (12.2%), Italy (10%), The Netherlands (7.6%) and Spain (5.4%). Others (Belgium, Turkey, Poland and Czech Republic) accounted for 19.5%. The UK, Germany and France provided more than 55% of the annual aerosol production in Europe in all segments. Together with Italy, The Netherlands and Spain, more than four billion units of aerosol dispensers were produced in 2022, said FEA.
