ASA releases Switzerland's filling statistics for 2022

er Schweizerische Aerosolverband (Swiss Aerosol Association or ASA) has released its data for 2022, sharing that 30.1 million aerosols were filled in Switzerland in the Personal Care, Pharmaceutical and Household Care product categories.

Aerosol dispensers in the Personal Care category accounted for 8.1 million units. These included body deodorant, hair spray, hair mousse, shaving cream and other personal care aerosol products.

With 18.2 million units filled, aerosols for households and/or commercial businesses represented the largest share, reported ASA. These products included insecticides, herbicides, carpet cleaner foam, room spray, furniture care, starch, car care products, technical sprays, paints and varnishes and other aerosols designed for residential and/or commercial use.

The smallest category, Pharmaceuticals, saw 3.8 million units filled. Products included pharmaceuticals, veterinary remedies and food sprays. SPRAY



FEA shares stats from China & Australia

The European Aerosol Federation (FEA) released the following information regarding aerosol production, decade over decade, in Australia and China

The FEA estimated (as firm data was not available) that Australia filled 240 million aerosol products in 2022; this is a 4.8% increase over the 229 million filled in 2012.

The FEA further reported that the People's Republic of China (PRC) produced 2.655 billion aerosols in 2022. It produced 1.554 billion in 2012, making for an almost 71% increase over the decade.

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
