

Spanish aerosol production in 2022

he Asociación Española de Aerosoles (Spanish Aerosol Association or AEDA) noted in its *Market Study on Aerosol Production* that aerosol fillings decreased by four million units (-1.21%) between 2021 and 2022, from 330 million units to 326 million units, respectively.

Personal Care led Spain's aerosol production with 149 million units. Household Care was not far behind with 105 million units. The "Other" category rounded out the results with 72 million units produced in 2022.

AEDA noted the slight decrease in Spanish aerosol production coincided with a strong increase in the cost of raw materials, compared to 2021. Some categories were adjusted for COVID-19 pandemic impact.

Lant Abogados conducted the research on behalf of AEDA, who explained that data is obtained from companies who have provided the information voluntarily, and as permitted by their internal policy. For 2022, sources of information were expanded to include valve manufacturers, packaging manufacturers, AEDA partner container fillers and container fillers who are not members of AEDA. SPRAY
